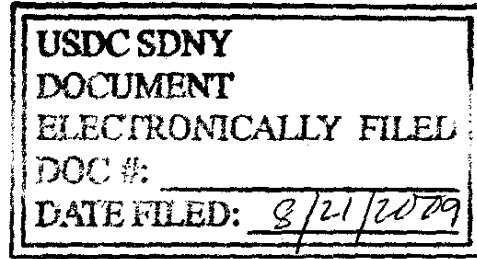


WHEREAS the Parties have agreed to a modification of the briefing schedule for Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction as set forth below,



- (2) Plaintiffs shall file and serve electronically their reply papers on or before November 20, 2009;
- (3) The Parties request that oral argument be rescheduled at the Court's convenience.
